Students have a right to feel safe and secure in school.

Our grade 8 students hold a special place in our school community since they are the oldest, and our younger students look to them for an example of good behaviors. While we hold all students to the highest standards for behavior and academics, I expect our oldest students to be role models for our younger children.

Whether your children are in pre-kindergarten or grade 8, please talk to them about good behaviors and study habits. What students learn in school will only be effective if it is reinforced at home. Education requires a partnership between faculty and parents; we cannot do it without you!
