To ensure success on the PARCC we encourage students to attend our Title I "After-School" program. Students may also arrange to see their teacher between 7:50 a.m. and 8:20 a.m. for extra help. If you have any questions or concerns about these programs, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.

To encourage your child to prepare diligently for the PARCC, the East Newark Board of Education has approved an incentive for students who improve their score from the previous year. Third grade students taking the PARCC for the first time will qualify for the incentive by "meeting" or "exceeding" expectations. Your child has received their scores from last year and he/she should understand their goal for this year. The enclosed form should be familiar to you. Please contact the school if you would like the specific information pertaining to your child.

I have also enclosed the "Rules & Regulations" to meet the incentive requirements. Successful students will qualify for a field trip to **MEDIEVAL TIMES** this fall, 2019. Students are excited about the challenge to improve their PARCC scores. I am asking you to support your child's efforts by encouraging him/her to do their homework and seek assistance from their teacher when necessary.

Finally, I am pleased to announce that effective Monday February 4, the district will be launching a new website. Our intention is to provide you with more detailed and up-to date information, including school closings. I invite you to visit the site frequently.

**Medieval Times**  
**PARCC Incentive**  
**Rules & Regulations**

To qualify for the fall 2019 educational field trip to Medieval Times:

- Students in grade 3 or those taking the PARCC for the first time, must score at least on level three in **both** ELA and Math.
- Students in grades 4 to 8 will qualify by:
  - Scoring 10 points higher in either ELA or Math, and not losing points in either ELA or Math.
    - For example, a student who goes from ELA 716 to ELA 726, and remains at Math 747 will qualify.
  - Scoring 10 points higher on aggregate ELA and Math.
    - For example, ELA score increases from 726 to 731 (+5 points) and Math increases from 705 to 710 (+5 points) total aggregate increase is 10 points, so the student qualifies.
  - Advancing one level in either ELA or Math, while not regressing a level in either ELA or Math.
    - For example, a student who advances in ELA from level 2 (724) to level 3 (725) and maintains a level Math on level 3 (730 to 725) will qualify.
  - Maintaining level 4 and 5 in **both** ELA and Math.
    - Levels 4 and 5 are the “Safe Zone.”
    - Students need only be on either level 4 or level 5 in both ELA or Math to qualify. However...
    - ...students must maintain levels 4 & 5 in ELA and Math to qualify.

To qualify students in grades 4 to 8 will:

Increase their PARCC scores by 10 points in either ELA or Math

Or

Increase to the next level

Or

Remain on level 4 or 5
